## Gary / Chicago International Airport Announces New Airport Manager

Key Hire Brings Wealth of Operations Experience to Chicago's 3rd Official Airport

(Gary, IN – February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021) The Gary / Chicago International Airport (GCIA) announced the hiring of Charles H. Sweet II, C.M., as the new airport manager for the Chicago region's 3<sup>rd</sup> official airport. Mr. Sweet is an aviation professional who works for AvPORTS, the private entity that oversees airport operations. Previously, he was Deputy Airport Director at Wittman Regional Airport in Oshkosh, WI and was an Airport Superintendent at Sheboygan (WI) Memorial Airport. Mr. Sweet is also a veteran of the United States Air Force, where he served as a Construction Project Inspector & Airfield Management Specialist.

"I'm excited to join the well-supported team at AvPORTS and to lead the Gary/Chicago International Airport into the future," **Sweet said.** "I look forward to getting into the trenches with the good people who work at GCIA, to learn from them and together chase excellence. An airport that maximizes its potential is not only good for business, but important for the community of Northwest Indiana and our neighbors in the Chicago Metropolitan Area."

Mr. Sweet comes to GCIA during a period when the airport is experiencing sustained growth and investment. The airport recently signed a long-term lease agreement with United Parcel Service (UPS) for cargo operations, with the initial operations having begun in November 2020. Recent years have also seen the creation of a brand new, state-of-the-art U.S. Customs and Border Protection Facility, allowing airport users to fly in from any worldwide destination without first needing to land at another airport to clear customs elsewhere.

"We are looking forward to working with Mr. Sweet," said Timothy Fesko, Chairman of the Gary/Chicago International Airport Authority. "The airport has seen significant growth and investment over the past several years. We feel Mr. Sweet has the experience and commitment to continue solidifying our role as the Chicago region's third official airport while being the premier mid-sized airport in the Greater Midwest."

In 2015, the main runway was expanded and now totals nearly 9,000 feet, giving Gary the second longest runway in the region after O'Hare International Airport and enabling the airport to service larger aircraft than Midway can accommodate. Since the runway's completion, airport operations are up nearly 15 percent, fuel revenue is up 82 percent and revenue derived from landing fees is up by over 140 percent.
