


Permission to Land Procedures

Gary International Airport (KGYY) is designated as a General Aviation Facility

Pilots must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departure from the foreign airport and 24 hours in advance of the anticipated arrival time at KGYY. Permission to land is granted with a tolerance of (+/-) 60 minutes. If your ETA deviates outside those parameters, you must contact CBP to resecure permission to land.

Inspection Process





- CBP Officer will meet aircraft on the ramp and begin screening process.
- Once a CBP officer has arrived, then the aircraft doors can be opened.
- All crew and passengers will be escorted to the adjacent General Aviation Facility (GAF) for CBP processing.
- Be prepared to present passports, visa, pilots license, medical certificate, aircraft registration and CBP user fee decal (if appropriate).
- A USDA compliance agreement is in place at this airport for the collection of regulated waste/ garbage.

Special Procedures/Miscellaneous

• Pilots/company must secure permission to land by contacting CBP prior to departing from foreign and at least 24 hours in advance of arrival weekdays and by 1800 local on Friday for any weekend arrivals or before normal hours on Monday mornings.
