The staging activities will occur between 10 am and 3 pm each day. Residents and visitors are invited to get close to the action once again and view the aerial participants taking off and landing from the airport's parking lot. The parking viewing area will be open from 9 am – 4 pm, with a \$20 parking fee per carload. Food trucks will also be on site.
