This position demands a strong work ethic, attention to detail, and the ability to work effectively both independently and as part of a team. The Seasonal Maintenance Worker will utilize a variety of tools and equipment to accomplish tasks in a timely manner, and must be adaptable to changing priorities and conditions. Employee must be prepared to work in various weather conditions and demonstrate a commitment to maintaining high standards of cleanliness and safety. This is an excellent opportunity for employee looking to gain hands-on experience in facility maintenance and contribute to the overall improvement of our operational environment.

Duties / Responsibilities

- Participates in the collection of trash and routine grounds keeping.
- Operates trimmers mowers, and other small engine equipment.
- Pick up sticks, limbs, and other branch material.
- Assist in tasks for painting airfield including laying shingles for overspray.
- Participates in snow removal activities and related duties as required
- Must be able to work with a group or complete assignments on own.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
